The M Club Story - Chapter 2

Dr. Byrd was named our first President. He appointed **Dr. Kemp** as Chairman of an Organization Committee consisting of the other six founders. They were charged with completing organization plans and drafting a proposed Constitution and By-Laws.

The Committee completed its assignment in the fall 1923 and also made arrangements for dedicating a new football stadium located near Ritchie Coliseum on Route 1 and subsequently named Byrd Stadium. Dr. Byrd raised \$69,500 to build the 5,000 seat stadium. He was the football, baseball, track coach and athletic director (1911-34) who became President of the university in 1936.

The Committee also drew-up plans for the first Homecoming Day for all alumni. The program for Homecoming, chaired by **Dr. Truitt**, included a morning freshman football game against Technical High; an afternoon varsity game against Catholic University (won by Maryland 40-6); a noon luncheon; a pep rally followed by a march to the new stadium; the first M Club meeting; and an alumni dinner followed by a dance.
